

HERITAGE ROLL CALL

The ROLL CALL is an Air Force tradition that brings unit members together to toast fallen comrades. It is also an opportunity to talk up UNIT HERITAGE, and provides an outlet to HAVE FUN away from daily operational stresses.

1. ROLL CALL (for serious reflection).
 - a. Start by selecting a unit member to act as "Mayor" (master of ceremony).
 - b. The Mayor calls out the name of every unit member, records their mandatory attendance (or alibi), and continues until calling out the name of a unit member who died in combat.
 - c. Have a 5-10 second moment of silence. Then, anyone else can call out the name of another fallen unit member, followed by another moment of silence. It is okay to go outside the unit and include any fallen Air Force comrade.

2. UNIT HERITAGE (to build pride in unit members).
 - a. Have a new unit member brief an event from unit history, or invite former unit members to speak.
 - b. Solicit the unit historian for help if needed.

3. HAVE FUN (in an environment of dignity and respect).

NOTE

After formal Roll Call, many units engage in a friendly, competitive game of "Crud". Whatever the activity, do it with INTEGRITY FIRST.
